The interview was conducted by Federal Bureau of Investigation, [REDACTED] - b(7)(c) 6, [REDACTED] - b(7)(c) 6, and [REDACTED] - b(7)(c) 6. [REDACTED] was advised of the nature of the interview and the identity of the interviewing agents. [REDACTED] - b(7)(c) 2, [REDACTED] - b(7)(c) 5	
[REDACTED] - b(7)(c) 5 refused to answer any questions that have been previously answered by him from prior interviews and is already contained within "the file."	
[REDACTED] - b(7)(c) 5 advised he "feels sorry" for Americans, due to the fact Americans are and will become targets in the Middle East. [REDACTED] - b(7)(c) 5 believes the planning of these attacks on Americans is already taking place in Middle Eastern countries, more specifically, the country of Yemen. [REDACTED] - b(7)(c) 5 advised these attacks on Americans will be a direct result for the incarceration of the "innocent" detainees, to include himself, at Camp Delta.	
[REDACTED] - b(7)(c) 5, [REDACTED] - b(7)(c) 5 advised he is dissatisfied with the treatment the detainees are receiving by U.S. Military personnel that are assigned to Camp Delta. [REDACTED] - b(7)(c) 5 advised he and others have been "beaten, spit upon and treated worse than a dog." [REDACTED] - b(7)(c) 5 elaborated on the fact that the U.S. Military Canine (guard dog) receives better care than the detainees. [REDACTED] - b(7)(c) 5 could not provide details pertaining to alleged beatings administered by the U.S. Military personnel.	
[REDACTED] - b(7)(c) 5 requested the interview to be terminated. Attempts to obtain information regarding the safety of Americans in Middle Eastern countries, was unsuccessful at this time.

Narrative: [REDACTED] Internment Serial Number (ISN) [REDACTED], was interviewed by Naval Criminal Investigative Service (NCIS) Special Agent (SA) [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] at Delta, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. Translation services were performed by [REDACTED] civilian. [REDACTED] voluntarily provided the following information: [REDACTED] stated that since his move next to [REDACTED], [REDACTED], he would fully cooperate with all interviewers. In addition, he stated that [REDACTED] has also decided to cooperate in the future. [REDACTED] provided the following additional information beyond his original story: [REDACTED] denied being part of any group or organization, and stated that he traveled to Afghanistan for two purposes. (1) He wanted to retrieve [REDACTED] and return him home for festivities with his family, and (2) wanted to act upon the fatwah issued by [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] when questioned about illegal drug trade stated that until arriving in Cuba, he did not know that heroin was produced and exported from Afghanistan. [REDACTED] denied having any affiliation with drug trade and having seen any drug activity during his travels. [REDACTED] when questioned about war crimes, stated that he fell victim to unjust abuse while in Kandahar, AF, by American soldiers. [REDACTED] stated that on the day of his transfer to Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, he and others were being medically examined in a large tent by the Americans. While restrained and lying on the floor face down he was punched several times by an unknown American soldier in uniform. [REDACTED] stated that he was being hit on his back (the exit wound from being shot). [REDACTED] also stated that an American soldier then kicked him, causing damage to his face and breaking a tooth. [REDACTED] stated that after he was kicked all the people in the tent laughed. The interview was subsequently terminated.
