4. REMARKS

Subject Interview of: (UNIK) [redacted] - b(7)(C)-5
Date/Place: 08 Nov 02/Guantanamo Bay, Cuba b(7)(C)-5
On 8 Nov 02, [redacted] Internment Serial Number (ISN) [redacted] was interviewed Camp Delta, United States Naval Base, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba by Special Agent [redacted] United States Army b(7)(C)-5

Criminal Investigation Command. The interview was conducted through Language Specialist [redacted] of the [redacted] b(7)(C)-2 in the [redacted] language. After being advised of the identities of the

interviewing agent [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 provided the following information: b(7)(C)-5

[redacted] b(7)(C)-5 was asked to describe his contact with the [redacted] b(7)(C)-5. [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 stated that he was brought into an interrogation room where [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 were present. The [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 told him the United States asked them to come and speak with [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 as they United States did not have any [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 translators. b(7)(C)-5

[redacted] b(7)(C)-5 stated that the [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 had all the information he provided to the US interrogators and was [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 promised would be kept from [redacted] b(7)(C)-5. [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 said they knew his real name and the fact that he had attended schooling in Lahore, PK and his home was in Kashkar. They also mentioned a place in his neighborhood which was only 1 kilometer from his home. [redacted] b(7)(F) stated that they [redacted] b(7)(F)

[redacted] b(7)(F) stated while in the [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 interrogation room they forcibly took his photograph and recorded the interrogation. The two [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 accused him of being a terrorist and of killing people. Initially an American male, who spoke [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 came in and told him to cooperate with [redacted] b(7)(C)-5

[redacted] b(7)(C)-5 stated they did not ask him about any questions about US Forces or the camp in Cuba or the [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 translation on Cuba. He stated he was questioned about the prison facility in Afghanistan and how it compared to Cuba. They asked where it was located and what he could see from the Camp and they also asked him, when he left home. They also asked how many prisoners where in each cell block. [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 stated he refused to answer their questions, which made [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 angry. The [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 told him that he can refuse to answer now, but when he comes back he would tell them the truth. [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 stated that the comment he "will" talk when he is returned made him believe [redacted] b(7)(F) until he told them the truth. b(7)(C)-5

[redacted] b(7)(C)-5 stated he has been truthful and honest about everything because he had faith in the United States. He stated the United States has broken its promise to him, which was not to release the information he provided to [redacted] b(7)(C)-5. Now [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 states [redacted] b(7)(C)-5, b(7)(F) stated he personally knows of events where [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 has [redacted] b(7)(C)-5 torture them [redacted] b(7)(F)

[redacted] b(7)(F) stated he knew of a friend, [redacted] b(7)(F)

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in prison. The [redacted] said the United States would put [redacted] on trial and it would be better to go back home [redacted] continued to refuse to answer their questions. [redacted] became angry and told him to think about it, when they were leaving the room, one of [redacted] turned the Air Conditioner down as low as it would go and left him in the room for approximately 7-8 without any food or water. According to [redacted] the room became so cold that he was shaking and his muscles hurt. [redacted] stated they did not physically abuse him while in the interrogation room.

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4. REMARKS (Continued)

[redacted] clarified comments documented in a prior interview by stating at the [redacted] training camp, there were no Arab or foreign trainers or students. He stated everyone at the Camp were [redacted]. The instructor [redacted] was also [redacted] said when the bombing started everyone fled into the mountains. He stated they found shelter in caves and stayed there until they ran out of food. [redacted] stated his group decided to go to Pakistan, but they did not know how to get there. [redacted] said while sitting in the cave he noticed a group of walk by and he went out and asked one of the where they were going. An Arab male told them he was going to Pakistan and [redacted] asked if his group could follow them. The Arab said they could, and he initially after leaving the cave he saw approximately 15-20 Arabs, but it became 70-80 Arabs. He stated none of the Arabs were carrying weapons and he did not ask them where they were coming from. [redacted] stated the trip took two days and they arrived at the end of Ramadan in Pakistan, in a village where the "Kaby" (sp) tribe lived. He said the village was celebrating the end of Ramadan and welcomed them and gave them food and tea. [redacted] stated they stayed in the village for approximately 15 days and in the middle of the night the villagers woke them up and stated it was not safe and they drove them [redacted] off to another area. He stated this is where the Pakistani Police came and arrested the [redacted] and the [redacted] Arabs. [redacted] stated that his group was never a part of the Arab group, he explained they followed them to Pakistan and everyone stayed in the village and ate. He stated the Villagers probably believed the two groups were actually one. [redacted] was asked where he would have gone if he had not been captured. He stated he would have went anywhere where he could be safe and live free. [redacted] stated he has never fought or engaged the US Forces and stated he never had any intention of fighting for the Taliban. [redacted] stated his sole purpose was to receive training to prepare himself for the time where [redacted] would fight [redacted] was asked why [redacted] had been declared a terrorist group [redacted] and the rest of the world. [redacted] believes that China is spreading lies about [redacted] stated [redacted] is strictly against the [redacted] suppression of the [redacted]. He further stated that [redacted] has no association with the Arabs and never would cooperate with them as the Arabs have a grudge against the United States. [redacted] stated [redacted] are not

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against the United States and [redacted] with their
fight against [redacted]

[redacted] in addition, [redacted] look up to the US and hope [redacted]

[redacted] stated that if the United States sends back the [redacted] that it
