[redacted] was interviewed at the United States Naval Base, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. Also present for the interview was Special Agent (SA) [redacted] Naval Criminal Investigative Service. The interview was conducted in Arabic, and Department of Defense contract language specialist [redacted]

[redacted] provided [redacted] translation. After being advised of the identity of the interviewing agent and the nature of the interview, [redacted] provided the following information:

[redacted] had heard that 40-50 detainees intended to commit suicide after Ramadan ended because they were tired of being detained with no prospect of being released and they were tired of being mistreated by the guards. [redacted] did not know how they intended to commit suicide but had heard that the act would only take about 10 minutes. [redacted] had no intention of committing suicide

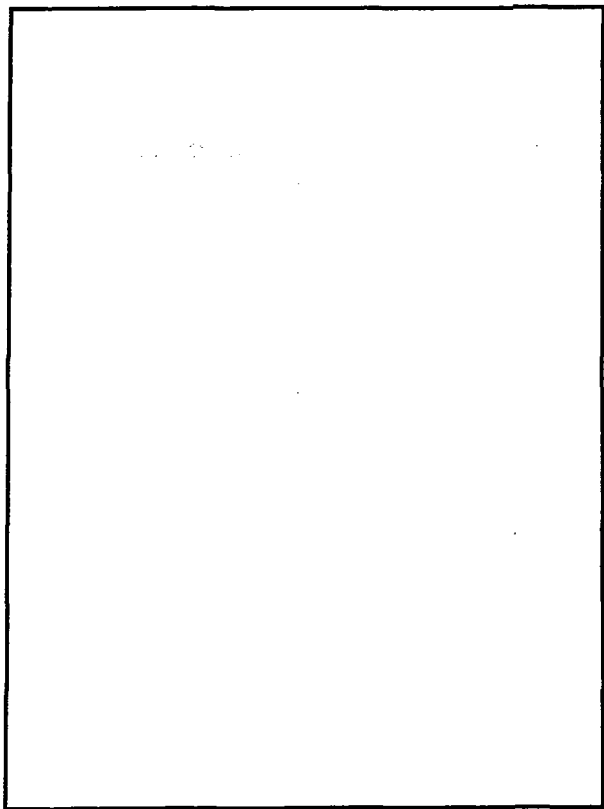
[redacted] was not aware of anyone in the camp who had admitted to being associated with AL QAEDA, however, there were many detainees who were TALIBAN fighters.

[redacted] requested to be moved from his current cell, which was close to the guard station, to an interior cell where it was more quiet. [redacted] explained that it was hard to pray and sleep so close to the guard station because it was always noisy there.

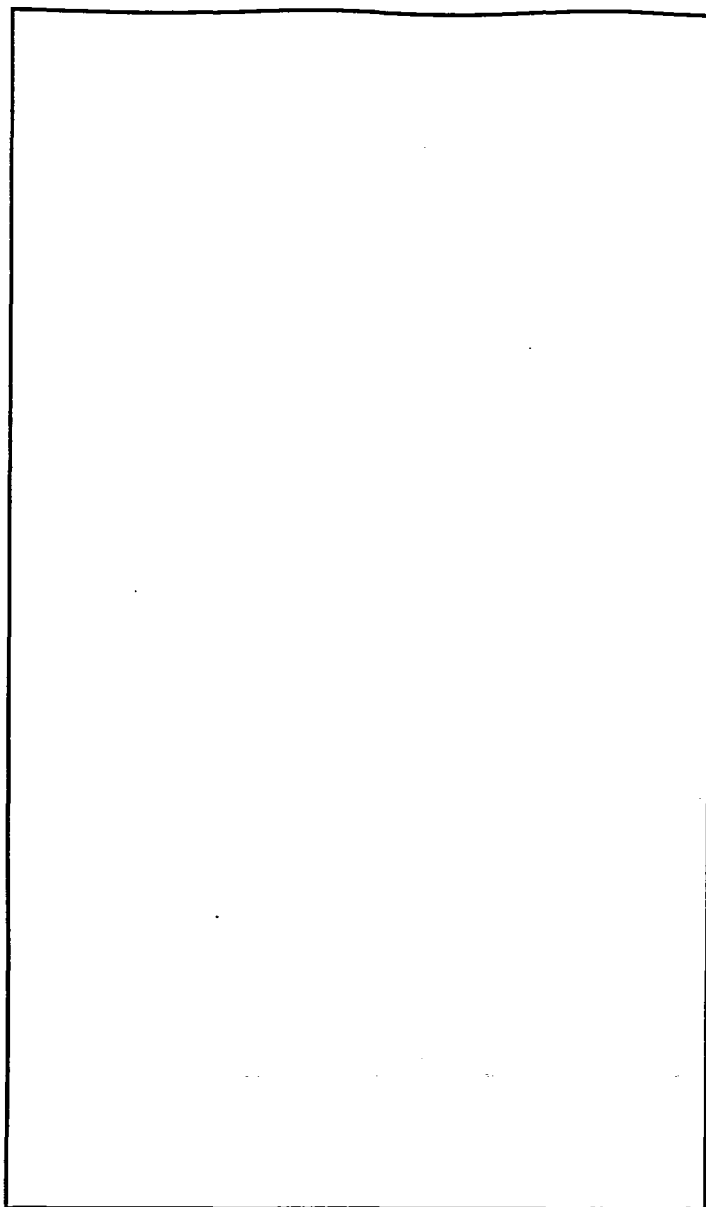
