1. ACTION REQUIRED: ACTION REQUIRED: -- PLEASE ENSURE THAT SUBSTANTIVE PORTIONS OF INFORMATION BELOW ARE SHARED WITH FBI HQS

2. OVERALL STATE OF PLAY: SUBJECT IS CURRENTLY IN THE TENTH DAY OF THE ISOLATION PHASE. AS REPORTED PREVIOUSLY, [Redacted] (SUBJECT) BEGAN THE ISOLATION PHASE OF THE [Redacted] CYCLE ON 18 JUNE 2002 AT APPROXIMATELY 1600 HOURS. THE ISOLATION WILL CONTINUE FOR APPROXIMATELY THREE WEEKS UNTIL THE [Redacted] RESUME CIRCA 11 JULY 2002. WE UNDERSTAND THAT IT MAY BE NECESSARY UNDER EXCEPTIONAL/EXCEPTIONAL AND URGENT CRISIS CIRCUMSTANCES TO INTERRUPT THE CAREFULLY SCRIPTED ISOLATION AN RISK LOSING ITS INTENDED EFFECTS. WE ARE PREPARED TO COVER THIS CONTINGENCY. JUST TO REVIEW, THE GOAL OF ISOLATION IS TO INDUCE DOUBT AND UNCERTAINTY ON THE PART OF THE SUBJECT ABOUT HIS DISPOSITION. DISRUPTING THE ROUTINE TO WHICH SUBJECT HAS BECOME ACCUSTOMED AND LIMITING HIS CONTACT WITH PEOPLE WILL INCREASE PSYCHOLOGICAL PRESSURE. ISOLATION WILL LIKELY BE HIGHLY DISCONCERTING TO THE SUBJECT GIVEN THE EXTENT OF HIS PRE-CAPTURE LEVEL OF ACTIVITY AND AFFINITY FOR INTERACTION WITH OTHERS AND HIS GENERALLY INTENSIVE POST-CAPTURE RATE OF INTERACTION WITH TEAM MEMBERS. IN THE OPINION OF TEAM PSYCHOLOGISTS, INTERRUPTING ISOLATION FOR ANYTHING LESS THAN EXCEPTIONAL/EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES MAY UNDERMINE THE PROCESS IN A WAY FROM WHICH IT IS DIFFICULT TO RECOVER. HOWEVER, IF AN EXCEPTIONAL/EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCE OCCURS [Redacted]

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[REDACTED] A PREPARED PACKET WITH SPECIFIC WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS WILL BE PRESENTED TO SUBJECT FOR HIS FEEDBACK WITHIN THE STRUCTURE OF THE ISOLATION PHASE. SUCH CONTACT WILL BE ACCOMPLISHED A WAY THAT MINIMIZES THE DISRUPTIVE EFFECT. THE RESULTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE SUBJECT'S RESPONSE WILL BE IMMEDIATELY FORWARDED TO ALEC/HQS. [REDACTED] TEAM MEMBERS IC SERE PSYCHOLOGIST, OPERATIONAL/SERE PSYCHOLOGIST, [REDACTED] OFFICER ARE PREPARED TO HANDLE ANY DEVELOPMENTS WHICH MAY ARISE. INTERROGATORS WILL RETURN ON SHORT NOTICE, AS REQUIRED.

3. ATMOSPHERICS/BEHAVIORAL COMMENTS: SUBJECT SPENT THE TIME BETWEEN THE LAST REPORTING PERIOD AND THIS ONE COMPLETELY ISOLATED EXCEPT FOR A SINGLE ROUTINE 30-MINUTE MEDICAL CARE SESSION (0800-0830, 28 JUNE 2002). DURING THE NIGHT AND DAY, THE SUBJECT'S ACTIVITY INCLUDED EATING FROM HIS BOWL OF BEANS AND RICE (AUGMENTED BY VITAMINS), DRINKING WATER AND ENSURE, WALKING ABOUT HIS CELL, SINGING, PRAYING, AND SLEEPING. THE SUBJECT ALSO TOOK TIME TO STRETCH HIS BACK, NECK, AND SHOULDERS. BETWEEN 0500 AND 0530, SUBJECT EXPERIENCED A COUPLE OF MINUTES OF SPITTING ONTO SOME SHEETS OF TOILET PAPER HE HAD PLACED ALONGSIDE HIS PAD. THE TEAM NURSE INDICATED THAT SUBJECT APPEARED TO HAVE DRY HEAVES WITH NO VOMITUS. NO BLOOD WAS NOTED IN THE PHLEGM AFTER THE SHEETS OF TOILET PAPER WERE RETRIEVED FROM HIS CELL. AFTER THE INITIAL EPISODE OF SPITTING, THE SUBJECT CLEANED UP THE TOILET TISSUE, SAT ON HIS PAD, AND OCCASIONALLY SPAT ONTO FRESH SHEETS OF TOILET PAPER. HE THEN LAID ON HIS PAD UNTIL HIS REST WAS INTERRUPTED BY THE 0800 MEDICAL CARE SESSION. SUBJECT MADE NO COMPLAINTS, DID NOT APPEAR WEAK OR IN DISTRESS, AND CONDUCTED HIMSELF AS USUAL. SEE BELOW FOR ADDITIONAL DETAILS REGARDING MEDICAL CARE SESSION. WHEN SITTING ON HIS PAD, SUBJECT CONTINUES TO OCCASIONALLY FINGER HIS NOSE, TOES, AND OTHER APPENDAGES. SUBJECT SHOWED NO SIGNS OF SEVERE EMOTIONAL DISTRESS. THE SUBJECT'S NOTE PAPER WAS BLANK. IN ADDITION, THE SUBJECT DID NOT WRITE ON THE LARGE RESPONSE SHEET LEFT FOR HIM TO USE TO IDENTIFY DETAILS RELATED TO CURRENT OR FUTURE THREATS.

4. ADDITIONAL OBSERVATIONS AND PLANS: NONE.

5. THREAT UPDATE: NO NEW THREAT INFORMATION TO REPORT AS OF THIS WRITING.

6. MEDICAL UPDATE: WOUND HEALING WELL. PHYSICAL EXAM COMPLETED. VITAL SIGNS WERE STABLE (BP: 120/88; PULSE: 102; TEMP: 35.6 CENTIGRADE). LUNGS WERE CLEAR ALL FIELDS. ABDOMEN WAS SOFT AND NON-TENDER. BOWEL SOUNDS WERE NORMAL. SKIN WAS COOL AND DRY. STOOL HEMOCULT WAS NEGATIVE. URINE OUTPUT WAS GOOD AND STOOL WAS FORMED AND SOFT. NO APPARENT DISTRESS OR DISCOMFORT REPORTED OR OBSERVED.
