DURING THE NIGHT AND DAY, THE SUBJECT'S ACTIVITY INCLUDED EATING FROM HIS BOWL OF BEANS AND RICE (AUGMENTED BY VITAMINS), DRINKING WATER AND ENSURE, WALKING ABOUT HIS CELL, SINGING, PRAYING, SLEEPING, AND WRITING ON HIS NOTE PAPER. HIS INITIAL WRITING SESSION LASTED ABOUT 40 MINUTES AND WAS ONLY INTERRUPTED BY OCCASIONAL PERIODS WHEN HE SAT, WITH PEN IN HAND, AND SEEMED CONTEMPLATIVE. HE STOPPED WRITING AT ABOUT 2140.
