[redacted] was interviewed at Camp Delta, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba by Federal Bureau of Investigations Special Agent [redacted] and United States Army Criminal Investigations Division Special Agent [redacted].

The interview was conducted in [redacted] language and translated by Contract Linguist [redacted].

[redacted] Mazar-e Sharif. He was there during the uprising; however, he did not witness anything because he was placed in the basement of one of the buildings. He heard a lot of gunfire and saw several wounded men in the basement. Many of the injured died from their wounds. He was then given to the Americans and taken to Kandahar.

[redacted] advised that he has been detained for a long time and the Americans should know the guilt or innocence of every detainee by now. He further noted that he understands America's reaction to 9/11 because it was something new; however, the treatment at Guantanamo Bay is unbearable. [redacted] advised it was worse than Hitler's treatment of the Jews.

[redacted] advised that there was a lot of problems with the guards. It is hard for him to ignore the way he is treated by the guards. He commented that the older guards are usually very nice and the younger ones cause a lot of the problems. They often disgrace the Koran by throwing it on the cell floor and frequently use profanity which many of the detainees find extremely offensive.
