A strong man does not need to show meanness to a weak man. The detainees are wearing handcuffs and chains and the guards and interrogators are not. But all men are human and should be treated with respect. "To be a human means respect." The water issue would not apply to the interrogators if they and the detainee are sharing water or tea out of respect for each other.
